Oregon Survey: Voter Attitudes Towards Measure 110

The Oregon survey of registered voters was conducted by Emerson College Polling and commissioned by Foundation for Drug Policy Solutions (FDPS), to measure public attitudes toward Measure 110.

Voters were asked which of the following statements comes closer to their view, even if neither is exactly right: Measure 110 should be repealed completely, or Measure 110 should be left as is. A majority of voters (56%) think the measure should be repealed completely, while 45% think it should be left as is.

Voters were also asked which comes closest to their view: parts of Measure 110 should be repealed that brings back penalties for the possession of small amounts of hard drugs, or Measure 110 should be left as is. A larger majority (64%) think parts should be repealed, while 36% think it should be left as is.

A majority (54%) of voters think Measure 110 has increased homelessness in their communities, while 38% think the measure has no impact on homelessness, and 8% think the measure has decreased homelessness.

When asked if they thought Measure 110 makes the community safer or less safe, half of voters (50%) say the measure makes the community much less safe (33%) or somewhat less safe (17%). Twenty percent (20%) of voters say the measure makes the community much safer (6%) or somewhat safer (14%). Thirty percent (30%) of voters say the community is about the same since the measure took effect.

Voters were split about the effects of funds from Measure 110 being used as part of a needle exchange program, which offers drug users clean needles in exchange for used needles. A third (33%) of voters think the program makes the community much safer (12%) or somewhat safer (21%). Forty-four percent (43%) of voters think the program makes the community much less safe (28.5%) or somewhat less safe (14.5%). Just under a quarter of voters (24%) think their communities are about the same.

Thirty-eight percent (38%) of voters say they are more likely to support a repeal of Measure 110 when presented with an audit of the measure which found that 1% of people cited for possessing controlled substances sought help via a new hotline provided as part of the measure, while a quarter (25%) of voters say they were less likely to support a repeal, and 38% say the information did not change their opinion on the measure.

Voters were also asked whether they were more or less likely to vote for a lawmaker if they voted to repeal Measure 110 in its entirety; 41% say they are more likely to vote for a lawmaker if they voted to repeal the measure, a third (33%) say they are less likely to vote for that lawmaker, and 25% say it would not impact how they vote.

The strongest area of support for Measure 110 is the 1st Congressional District and the strongest opposition is in the 2nd Congressional District.

A majority of Oregon voters (58%) think the state is on the wrong track, while 42% think it is headed in the right direction.

Poll Methodology

The Oregon poll consisted of registered voters in Oregon, n=1,000, with a margin of error of +/-3%. Data was collected August 8-9, 2023 and administered by contacting landline telephones via Interactive Voice Response (IVR), emails via a voter list of emails, and online panel. Data was weighted by gender, age, education, race/ethnicity, region, and party registration based on 2024 turnout models.
